InteRussia is an international fellowship program launched in 2021 by ANO "Mezhdunarodniki" in cooperation with the Gorchakov Fund and key Russian institutions. It provides young specialists from around the world with an opportunity to gain hands-on experience in Russia's leading research institutions, cultural centers, and industry organizations.



The program is designed for professionals seeking advanced training, mentorship, and global networking. Since its inception, over 300 fellows from more than 70 countries have participated, building strong professional connections and deepening their expertise in various fields.

# WHO CAN JOIN INTERUSSIA?

InteRussia is open to young professionals from around the world who are eager to enhance their expertise, gain hands-on experience, and build international connections.

Each fellowship has specific requirements, but the general eligibility criteria include:

(varies by specialization)

Non-Russian citizens only

Applicants must have education and/or work experience in one of the following fields:

- Russian Language & Linguistics

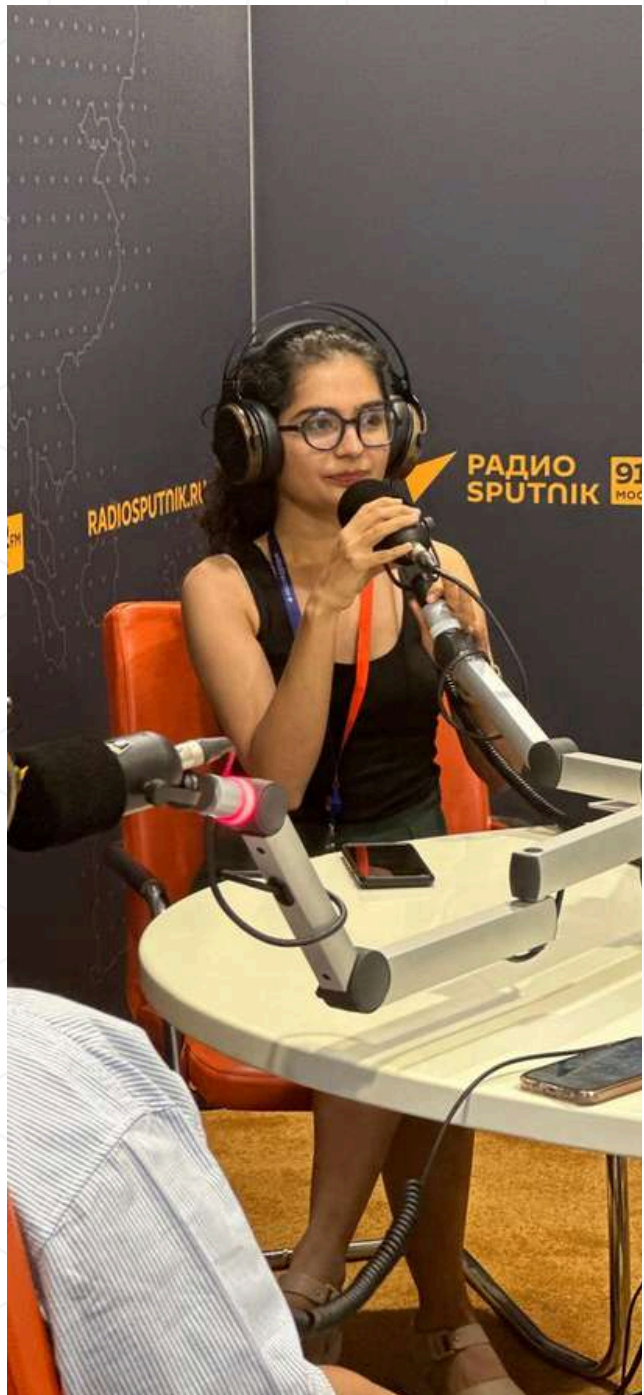

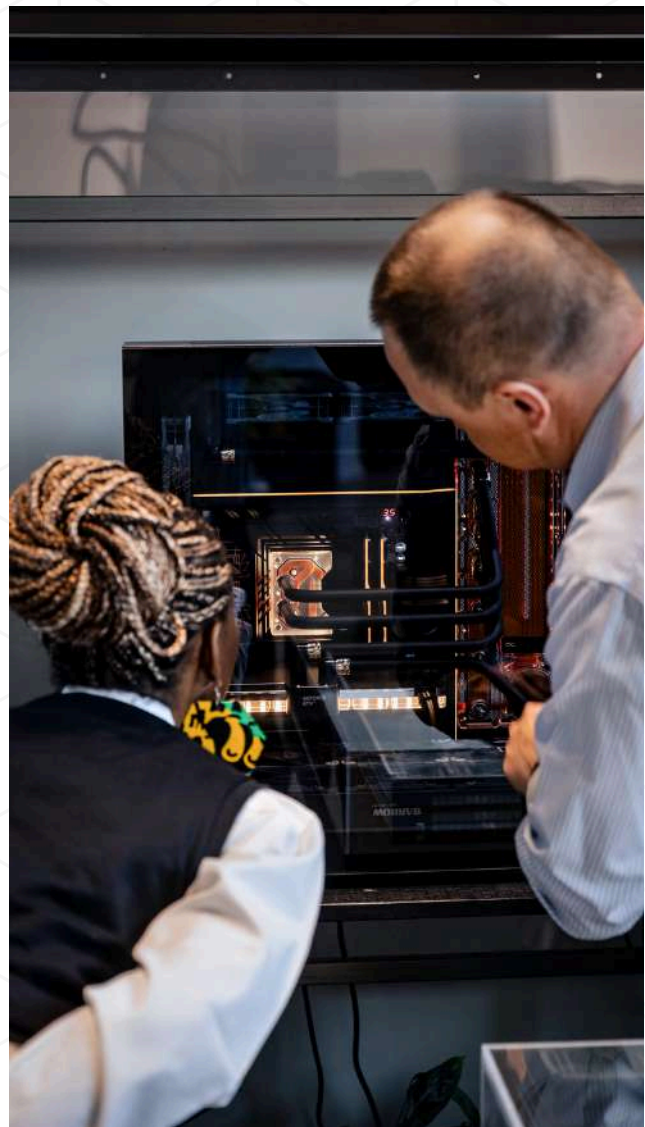

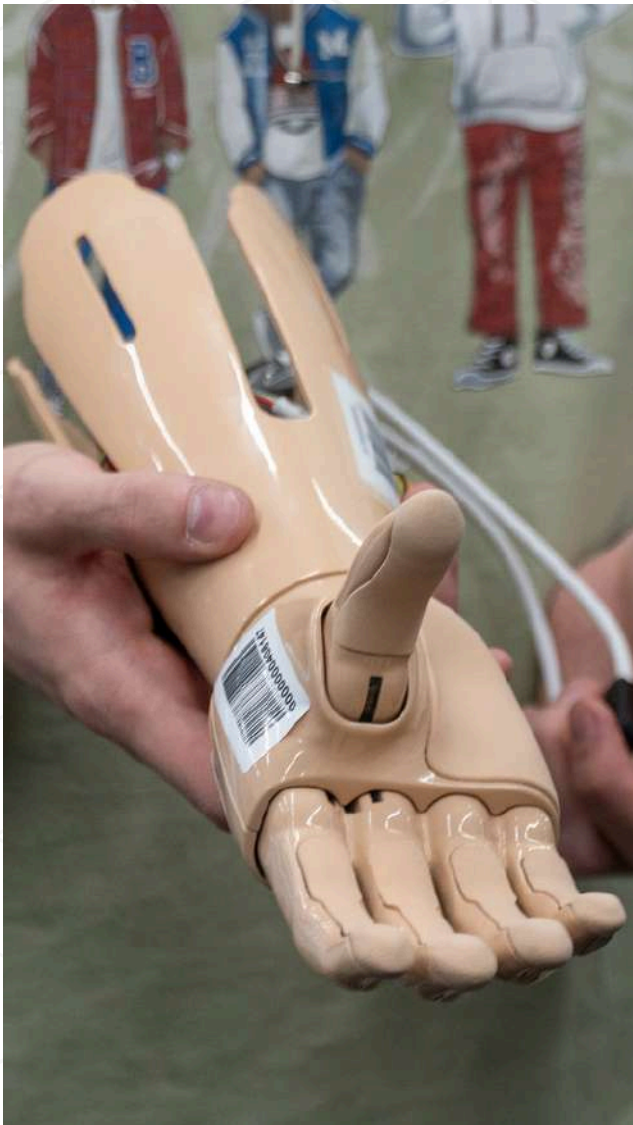

Click "Create Application," select the relevant InteRussia fellowship, and confirm your choice.

## Submit the required documents

---

CV/Resume.

Motivation letter detailing your interest in the fellowship.

Research proposal (if applicable) outlining your planned project.

## Finalize and submit your application

---

Ensure all required fields are filled.

Click "Submit Application" and wait for the status to change from "In Progress" to "Submitted".
